- a. Resolution 20-01 Establishing Reimbursement from Duck Club Owners for Aerial Application Cost.

Manager Snyder gave a power point presentation describing the history of the cost share agreement with landowners in the Suisun Marsh. Trustee Stevenson asked if all of the landowners are participating in the program. Manager Snyder stated that in the 2019 fall flood season that 95% had turned in waiver and participated in the program. Landowners who do not participate pay 100% if their duck club is treated aerially. Unanimously approved on motion by Trustee M. White seconded by Trustee R. Schock.
